Knitting Pattern for Barbara's duster

Long and fluffy, perfect for getting inbetween Bernard's nick-nacks!



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You will need:

1 x kebab stick

Small amount of DK yarn in:

Light brown, red, yellow, blue and pink

3mm knitting needles

Instructions:

Cut a 10cm length from the blunt end of the stick discarding the pointed end.

Cast on 4 sts in light brown yarn.

Knit in stocking stitch to cover the stick.

Cut yarn leaving a 20cm length. Thread yarn through stitches from the knitting needle, gather and fasten. Push end of the stick into the gathered end of the knitting and then sew the two edges together around the stick using an over stitch. Gather cast on edge to close over the end of the stick. Fasten off and weave in end.

Cut the red yarn into 5cm lengths, about 20 pieces in total. Bind to the top of the stick as in diagram using matching yarn.

Cut the same amount of the other colour yarns and repeat the process using the illustrations as a guide.

Fluff the ends out and trim to shape with scissors.

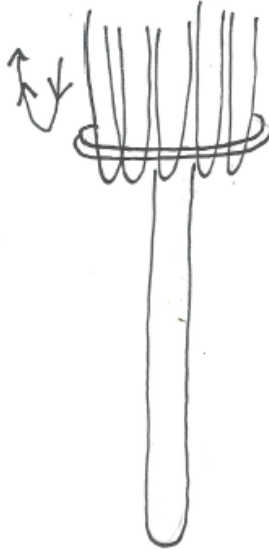

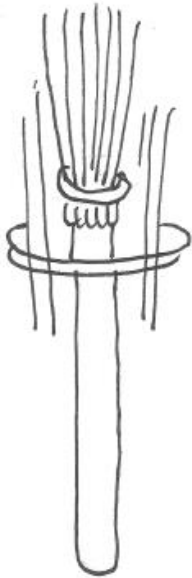
Arrange yarn strands around top of stick. Bind tightly in centre of yarn.

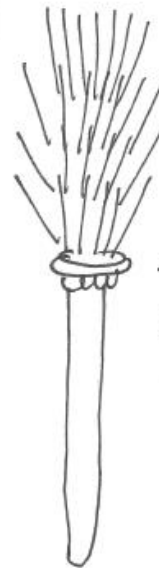
- Fold bottom strands of yarn up and over binding. Bind again in same place, keeping tight.

Cut second colour yarn into strips. Place over bound yarn with centre of strips $\frac{1}{2}$ cm down from previous binding. Bind tightly + repeat stage 2.

Repeat stages 3 + 2 with remaining 2 colours. Trim into shape carefully.



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
